2. Purpose


The purpose of this Customer Tip is to advise how to upgrade the firmware of the Fuji Xerox device via the EP Service.

3. Precautions

The prerequisites for this Customer Tip are that the Fuji Xerox device is registered to the EP Service and successfully communicating. This procedure must be completed via the Control Panel of the device only. The firmware upgrade process will take approximately 30minutes to complete. The device will be unavailable during this time. The device must not be switched off during this process. Saved documents and settings will not be changed.


4. Procedure

1. Press the silver [Services Home] button on the Control Panel.
2. Press the [Login/Out] button on the Control Panel.




3. Enter the System Administrator's User ID and then select [Enter] on the Touch Screen. If 'Enter' is unavailable, select [Next] and then enter the System Administrator's Passcode then select [Enter].

NOTE: The default System Administrator User ID is: 11111 and the default System Administrator Passcode is: x-admin.




4. Select [Tools] from the right of the 'Services Home' screen.



5. Select [Maintenance] from the 'Features' column.

NOTE: If the button [Software Upgrade] is available, skip to step 12.


6. Select [Check EP Connection].



7. Select [Check Connection].



8. Wait for the message 'Connection with the Remote Center has been established' and press [Confirm].



NOTE: If any other message is displayed, then select [Cancel] and then select [Close] repeatedly to exit the 'Tools' menu.


If you encounter an error message at this stage, please contact us for further assistance.

9. Repeatedly press close to exit the 'Tools' menu.

10. Press the green [Admin] button at the top right corner of the display, and then select [Logout].



11. Repeat steps 1 to 5 to login as admin and then proceed to the next step.
12. Select [Software Upgrade].




13. Wait for the Fuji Xerox device to communicate with the EP Server.



14. Select [Start Upgrade]. DO NOT SWITCH OFF THE DEVICE DURING THE FIRMWARE UPGRADE



NOTE: If 'Unable to retrieve the Software Version' is displayed, then press [Cancel] and exit the 'Tools' menu by repeatedly pressing [Close] at the top right of screen.



15. The software download will begin, and a download progress bar will be shown.

NOTE: The download may be cancelled at any time to return the device to normal service. Any download progress will be discarded.

16. Once the download is complete, the firmware will be automatically applied to the Fuji Xerox device and the following messages will be displayed on the User Interface.

⚠ CAUTION: The firmware update process will take approximately 15 minutes to complete. Do NOT turn off the machine until the update is complete.



